- **Yellow dorsals**
 - **Group 1:** no pacemakers
- **Purple dorsals**
 - **Group 2:** 1 hour and 15 minutes' pacemaker
- **Green dorsals**
 - **Group 3:** two pacemakers, one at 1h 20m and another at 1h and 25m
- **Red dorsals**
 - **Group 4 :** two pacemakers, one at 1h 25m and another at 1h and 30m
 - **Group 5:** two pacemakers, one at 1h 25m and another at 1h and 30m
- **Blue dorsals**
 - **Group 6:** two pacemakers, one at 1h 33m and another at 1h and 40m
 - **Group 7:** two pacemakers, one at 1h 33m and another at 1h and 40m
 - **Group 8:** two pacemakers, one at 1h 33m and another at 1h and 40m
 - **Group 9:** two pacemakers, one at 1h 33m and another at 1h and 40m
- **Orange dorsals**
 - **Group 10:** two pacemakers, one at 1h 45m and another at 1h and 50m
